

OPC C4ISR Test Representative

Job Summary

Work with the OPC Test Manager and all required Production Crafts, Contractors, and ESG Engineering, Purchasing and Program Office, to ensure all tests and validations are fully accomplished on the Offshore Patrol Cutter (OPC) program, in support of schedule, cost and performance requirements.

Job Duties

Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays. Support the C4 and Test Teams in execution of a robust total ship test program including, but not limited to, development of test processes and procedures for all C4ISR areas. Shall develop test reports, to include land based, shipboard (pier side and underway), and Navy INSURV acceptance trials. Shall be able to work as test representative for C4ISR systems, and ability to lead the production team thru the installation check-out, grooming, and operation of assigned systems. Be able to demonstrate proper operation of equipment and systems to USCG and INSURV. Work with Production, QA, and Engineering to ensure 100% corrective actions, within the assigned areas, are completed. Apply all trial cards and deficiencies discovered during test/QA and work to have them corrected on future platforms. Work with the C4 Test Lead to de-conflict competing priorities during all Testing and Activation projects to deliver results within financial and schedule specifications. Support the Test lead in production, test, launch, and trials Readiness Reviews within assigned area. Support the Test lead during Pre and Post Sea Trials meetings within assigned area. Support Test lead in coordinating with Engineering and Project Management to ensure that the shipyard testing strategy is being followed in assigned areas. Perform other duties as assigned.

Education/Experience: High school diploma or GED equivalent. Three more years' experience shipboard testing, developing procedures, performing test validation, verifying pre-requisites, and documentation into deliverable test reports. Civilian or Military experience in the C4ISR field will also be considered. Experience developing test procedures using ABS NVR highly desired. Must be able to quickly understand basic system operation, and integration with C4ISR systems. Must be able to effectively troubleshoot issues and failures. Experience with integration of a test program into Program Integrated Master Schedule (IMS), starting with design through fabrication, construction, and delivery preferred. Requires the ability to obtain and maintain a SECRET security clearance.

Skills: Intermediate level Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point and Outlook experience. Working knowledge of various web-based design and collaboration tools desired. Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, Company policies/procedures, and governmental regulations. Ability to interpret contract requirements, specifications, and drawings into a comprehensive test program. Ability to multi-task and prioritize tasks with strict deadlines. Ability to effectively present information, brief presentations and respond to questions from senior management, employees, government officials and the public. Effective written and verbal communication skills required. Ability to forge and sustain outstanding client-relationships while managing multiple work streams. Ability to multitask and work in a fast-paced environment and have an attention to detail. Ability to work both independently and as part of the project team while exercising diplomacy and tact.
